Hello Everyone:

Please note the following:

To expedite processing and clearances, Flushing Hospital will accept the " 7 Panel Drug Screening" from an outside certified lab. The result must be on the lab's letterhead and must be dated within 6 months of the student's/intern's start date.

All students screened outside must bring this documentation with them to their Occupational Health (OHS) appointment, along with the results of their recent physical, PPD/chest xray, tetanus vaccine date, measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, and Hep B titers.

All students/interns must call for an appointment prior to coming to OHS.

If students/interns are unable to get screened prior to arrival at Flushing and thus are unable to bring the drug screen result, Occupational Health will do the drug screening, this may delay the process and delay the commencement of rotations.

If students/interns were previously Respirator Fit Tested , they should bring documentation of which mask and size for which they were tested.

If it is the same as used at their assigned facility, it will also be accepted, if not, they will have to be done again when they come to OHS.
