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I. Welcome to Canvas!

Starting January 1st, 2018 all clinical students will use Canvas as the Learning Management System (LMS) to replace eCollege. Clinical Clerkship guidelines and resources will be available on Canvas, as well as the Transition to Clinical Medicine Program (TCM).

Along with the introduction to Canvas, we are debuting our updated Clinical Curriculum. The updated Clinical Curriculum represents revamped guidelines to clerkships along with improved guidance and resources to improve your educational experience.

By the Fall of 2018, both medical sciences and clinical sciences will be on the same LMS allowing both students and faculty to view content and resources across the four years of medical school.

The goal of this guide is to familiarize you with the Canvas environment.

Please note that Canvas does not replace E*Value. All patient encounters still need to be logged on E*Value and a PDF of your case logs needs to be submitted by email to the Office of the Registrar at the end of each clerkship.

II. Logging onto Canvas

Figure 2. Canvas Forgot Password?




- ii. Enter your D#

Figure 3. Dashboard




IV. Features of Canvas

a. Course Homepage

The Course Homepage is where you will see a welcome note from the Clinical Chair of that specialty. There are also links for the Syllabus, Modules, and Help below the welcome.

b. Course Syllabus

The Course Syllabus includes contact information for the Clinical Chair of that specialty as well as course objectives, information about the NBME Shelf Exam, work hours, and attendance policy among others.


Figure 5. Course Syllabus


Figure 6. Modules
