Apartment rooms

Housing assignments are made on a first-come, first-serve basis. A \$1,650 security deposit is required to reserve housing. Student rooms are either single or double occupancy. Double rooms come with a balcony facing the lagoon and each room has its own private bathroom. The per person rental fee is:

How do I get my apartment keys?

Once you arrive at the airport, take the shuttle or a taxi to the AUC campus, which is about a 10-minute drive. Housing personnel will be available on campus to hand you your University Apartment envelope, that includes:

- Your apartment key
- Apartment Rules and Regulations manual
- Apartment meeting invitation
- Apartment check-in form

- Apartment work order form
- Guest visitation form
- Residential Advisors' contact information

If your flight is delayed, or if you arrive on the island after the University Housing Office is closed, you can retrieve your apartment key from the security guard.
